has been scheduled for Dec. 6, 2018 from 10am to 7pm. Refreshments will be served. Come join us and sign up for prizes.

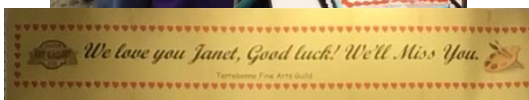
