Part of the judge's statement follows:

I would like to thank the Guild for the opportunity to judge the Spring Exhibition. There are strong artists and artworks represented in this exhibition, and I hope that everyone continues to make their work and feed their curiosity about art.

I never thought I'd award "Best of Show" to a swamp scene with egrets. It's a much overused regional trope, like lighthouses in Maine, palm trees in South Florida, and octagonal barns in Wisconsin. But Delores Legendre's oil painting "Snowy Egret – Cypress Swamp Log" is shocking. It has a surface that reminded me of an Ivan Albright painting, with a surface that almost vibrates. It also reminded me of paintings by Tom Uttech, a mid-western painter whose scenes of nature are subtly supernatural. Ms. Legendre has shown that there is something new to be found in this old genre.

This show represents an art community that is working together, and learning from itself, and will in its way, change the world.
