Mickey Guillory is Artist of the Month for May. Mickey is fascinated by the relationships of land and water and the way this affects cultural development. Her paintings in oil and pastel reflect her response to this environment.



In middle school and high school, Guillory was fortunate to receive an art education which included pastel, oil painting and hand-built ceramics. Her formal art education continued at LSU where she received a B.S. degree. She also studied at Louisiana College and the New Orleans Academy of Fine Arts with additional instruction from a number of generous art teachers. She has taken numerous art workshops with notable instructors, recently with plein-air painter Phil Sandusky of New Orleans at Ardoyne Plantation.

Mickey's artwork has been accepted in juried exhibits, including the Degas Pastel Society exhibit at the Louisiana State Archives and the Tom Peyton Memorial Art Exhibit in Alexandria where she received a Merit Award. Guillory was honored to receive the "Best-in-Show Award" sponsored by Les Artistes du Bayou at the French Food Festival in 2018.

Mickey holds membership in several art organizations, including the Terrebonne Fine Arts Guild and the New Orleans Art Association. She is also a signature member of the Degas Pastel Society.
